Citrus Cel is looking for those strong, well-made narrative works to correspond with the Animation Film Festival. This inaugural exhibition will be a major counterpart to the festival to celebrate great design in animation and illustration. Works submitted are to be of a narrative form. Film and book illustration is recommended. Types of work accepted include:

- General (narrative)
- Concept designs
- Character designs
- Storyboards
- Graphic novels
- Children's books

In addition to the Storytelling Art Exhibition, student-only work from the Design in Character Student Competition will be on display.

Design in Character Student Competition

Character design is an art form of its own. Every designer's ability to create is broadened by the necessity of capturing an audience's attention and telling the story through visual character interpretation. Open to students only, the Design in Character Student Competition will showcase the excitement of character design inspiration, technique and storytelling.

Deadline for all submissions:

March 19, 2010

Eligibility:

All submissions to The Citrus Cell Animation Film Festival Juried Art Show need to consist of content that has been completed no earlier than January 01, 2007. Submissions should relate back to completed work, whether selected for final use in production or not. Works in progress will not be accepted.

This may include scanned sketches, photography, screen captures, etc. submitted electronically in any of the following formats:

We recommend each submission be of the highest quality possible. These files will be judged for selection – the better the quality, the better chances of getting in to the show.

In addition, each submission must include a completed entry form (scanned or emailed with the information). Entries must be received on or before March 19, 2010. Entrants will be notified via email after your entry has been received.

Please do not mail in any submissions, as all work is juried electronically. Mailed in submissions will not be returned.

Contributors of artwork selected will be notified via email early March 2010 and asked to send in selected artwork at that time. Selected submissions will need to be received on or before March 31, 2010.

Student Competition Awards:

One prize will be awarded to the student winner in the Design in Character Student Competition for artwork showcasing exceptional design, inspiration and technique.

Winner will be announced before the closing program on Sunday, April 11, 2010 at the 5 Points Theater.

Student Competition Judges:

Varick Rosete, president of AIGA Jacksonville, Shane Douberly of Dripsblack and a special Guest Judge.

Judges will look for the true creativity of the entry. Entries should be a celebration of the creative spirit. All entries will be judged and notified via email early March 2010.

Show Dates:

The Art Center will host the show during the Downtown Jacksonville Art Walk – April 7, 2010, and be open during the festival from April 9-11, 2010.
